



80th Independence Day of India Celebrated in Yerevan (Armenia)

The Embassy of India in Yerevan (Armenia) celebrated the 80th Independence Day of India on 15 August 2026 at the Chancery premises.

Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of India to the Republic of Armenia, H.E.
