Subject: Maintenance and Cleaning of Gardens at Chancery Building of the Embassy of India and Residence.

1. Background:

This Request of Proposal is for hiring of gardeners for Embassy of India (Chancery) at 50/2, India Street, Yerevan and Embassy Residence at Aygedzor Street, 1st Lane, House No. 32, Yerevan.

2. Scope of Work

The broad and indicative, but not exhaustive, spectrum of works expected to be provided by the companies are listed below

(a) Gardener: 1(One) – Qualified gardener to maintain gardens at Embassy (Chancery) and Embassy Residence. The gardener should be well qualified and experienced in maintenance of garden. The gardener is expected to carry out works like trimming of trees, cutting of grass at regular intervals, apply/spraying insecticides, growing plants/ trees, cleaning grass/foilage etc.

(b) Working Scheduler: Monday to Friday (0900 hrs to 1730 hrs working days only) at both the places. In addition to gardening they may be asked to undertake maintenance or other petty work in the Embassy or Embassy Residence. The gardener may be asked to come on holidays, in case their services are required by the Embassy.

(c) Gardening tools, seeds, saplings, manure, pots etc. will be provided by the Embassy as per requirement.

(d) During off seasons, gardeners will be required to work as snow cleaners and do other maintenance/petty work as decided by the Embassy and also look after indoor plants.

3. Inviting bids from Companies

In this context, the Embassy of India would like to invite offer(s) from companies in Yerevan dealing with gardening work through Limited Tender in **sealed cover**. Offer should be in Armenian Dram (AMD) only **at per month rate**, without VAT. Companies may send their representatives

to conduct the survey of the sites to take stock of work including measurement of area from 1400hrs to 1600hrs on working days.

4. Important Notes

- (i) Prospective bidders should submit a lump sum quote for both the gardens.
- (ii) The quotation / envelope should have date and signatures of the authorized signatory of the service provider with stamp.
- (iii) Bids in local language should be accompanied by certified English translation.
- (iv) The payment will be made directly in the account of the Company.

The decision regarding award of work will be taken after due consideration of the bid, scope of work etc. The final decision would remain with Embassy of India, Yerevan and the Embassy owe no explanation to anyone about the selection process of the company for the job.
