SECURITY ADVISORY FOR INDIAN CITIZENS/TOURISTS VISITING GEORGIA

It has come to the notice of the Embassy that the incidents of violence, loot and robbery targeting visiting Indian tourists have been rising in Georgia near the City Centre. The incidents of robbery, loot are being carried out by a gang of teenagers/kids under organized crime. Recently, few such incidents took place against Indian tourists. Police have often not taken adequate action despite complaints.

- 2. In view of the increasing incidents of violence, loot and robbery in Tbilisi, Georgia, the Embassy has strongly taken up these cases with the relevant Georgian authorities and would advise Indian citizens/tourists to take necessary precaution to ensure physical safety while visiting Georgia and avoid visiting crowded places in Georgia, particularly in Tbilisi.
